GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Check or verify your school/building assignments at the PRC official website (www.prc.gov.ph) or thru the Notices/ Announcements to be posted at the PRC premises two (2) to three (3) working days before the date of examination. Bring your NOTICE OF ADMISSION when you verify your school/building assignment. Visit your school/building assignment prior to the day of the examination.
2. Report to the school/building assignment before 6:30 AM on the first day of the examination to verify your room and seat number. Be punctual, late examinees will not be admitted. Examination Fee of ABSENT Examinees will be forfeited.
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire every examination day:

Male Examinees	-	White polo shirts or T-shirts with collar.
Female Examinees	-	White blouses or T-shirts with collar, decent pants or slacks or skirts

4. Bring the following on examination day:
- Notice of Admission
 - Official Receipt
 - One piece metered-stamped window mailing envelope
 - Two or more pencils (No. 2)
 - One ballpen with **black ink only**
 - one piece long brown envelope
 - one piece long transparent/plastic envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
 - Non-programmable Calculator (refer to list on the Examinees Guide).
5. The following are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms.
- Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula (except Rules VII & VIII of the 2004 Revised IRR of P.D. No. 1096/1977 NBCP as qualified below)
 - PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS.**
 - Cellular phones**, beepers, portable computers or similar gadgets/devices.
 - Bags of any kind (ladies bag, shoulder bags, attache case, backpacks, etc.)
 - Other examination aides not stated on this program shall not be brought inside the examination building.

NOTE: PRC WILL NOT BE ANSWERABLE FOR PROHIBITED ITEMS THAT WILL BE LOST.

6. Read carefully and follow the instructions on your **Notice of Admission** and **Examinees Guide**.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- On the second day (January 29, 2016), every candidate is required to bring to the examination room architect scales (English and Metric Scales), 30 x 60 and 45 degree triangles, protractors, calculators, pencils, drawing pens, erasers, graphed paper and other tools for sketching purposes.
- Download copy of Rules VII and VIII of the 2004 Revised IRR of P.D. No. 1096 "1977 National Building Code of the Philippines (NBCP).
- Free download only from the Latest Publication Section of PRBoA Website at www.architectureboard.ph
- Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination rooms, borrow anything or communicate with one another on any subject matter. Every candidate is required to bring his/her lunch and/or supper (placed inside transparent/plastic bags) with him/her during the examination. No food of any kind carried by any persons intended for any candidate during the progress of the examination shall be entertained by watchers or received by any candidate.
